## WHAT IS RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING?

Recognition of Prior Experiential Learning (RPEL) is an assessment method that recognises a practitioners previous informal education, training and experience. RPEL assessment will enable practitioners to proceed straight to assessment without undertaking a full learning programme.

## THE MAP-IQ FASTTRACK RPEL ASSESSMENT PROCESS

The MAP-IQ RPEL assessment process allows experienced practitioners to go straight to assessment without the need to repeat previous learning. MAP-IQ provides resources and reading materials to guide practitioners through each stage of the assessment process. Successful completion of an RPEL mapping exercise will allow practitioners to proceed to the written exam. and OSCE

# The 3 Stage Assessment Process

#### **STAGE 1. RPEL Mapping Exercise**

Stage 3 requires the learner to meet with a MAP-IQ assessor to map thier previous learning and experience to a range of leanring outcomes

#### **STAGE 3. Written Exam**

Stage 3 requires the learner to complete an online written exam to meet the learning outcomes across all units.

#### **STAGE 4. Clinical Skills OSCE**

Stage 4 requires the learner to demonstrate clinical skill in the administration of a botulinum toxin and soft tissue filler treatment.

Successful completion of the three-stage assessment pathway signifies the end of the assessment process and the achievement of a Level 7 Diploma in Clinical Aesthetic Injectable Treatments. Aesthetic practitioners can then use the following post-nominal title after their name. PGDipAes (VTCT).

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Entry is only open to Regulated Medical and Healthcare Practitioners with no conditions attached to practice. In addition, applicants must be able to evidence:

- provisional registration on Part A of the JCCP Practitioner Register
- Botulinum Toxin and soft tissue filler training.
- 2 years of experience performing clinical aesthetic injectables.
- Completion and declaration of a MAP-IQs entry assessment
- A reference from a regulated medical or healthcare professional
- Full indemnity insurance to cover clinical aesthetic procedures.
- English language level of IELTS 7.0 in all components or equivalent if English is not the first language.

Learners are not required to be independent prescribers but they must be supervised for their practice-based OSCE by a prescribing practitioner who holds an appropriate qualification and or experience in clinical aesthetic practice.
